Analysis of Results - Key Qualitative Findings:

"I'm not sure if this was the intended takeaway, but how easy it can be to incorporate assessment in our work. Sometimes you don't need to over think it!"

"Advertise accurately what will occur."

"Please be prepared to use microphones. Nobody's voice carries far enough for a person who is hard of hearing. Could have placed tables closer to the speaker in the large room."

"it would be great to highlight some additional models of how we are doing the work of assessment across the division and having those resources to inspire one another and tell the story of our areas."

Analysis of Results - Key Quantitative Findings:

100% of participants felt the quantitative session was useful for their work.

94.73% of participants felt the qualitative session was useful for their work.

Outcome Statement:

Greater than 90% of participants (n=20) (N=52) found both the qualitative and quantitative sessions useful for their work.

The outcome was met because more than 90% of the respondents stated that both the quantitative and qualitative sessions would be useful in their work.

Actions Taken :
